"I know it's complete madness, but we had been watching the development for a good while and we had our heart set on that particular release."

Despite the cold winter temperatures, Ms Wyszeccki said they were very well prepared.

"We borrowed a camper trailer from a work colleague and had the heater on full - so we were totally set," she laughed.

AVJennings executive general manager Peter Jackson said the popularity of the development had exceeded all expectations.
